## (ii) Clean Air Hamilton 2011 Progress Report (BOH12015) (City Wide) (Item 7.2)

Dr. McCarry, Chair of Clean Air Hamilton, gave a presentation to the Board with the assistance of PowerPoint presentation. A copy of the presentation was obtained for the official record.

Dr. McCarry discussed the objectives of Clean Air Hamilton, and gave an overview of their work. Dr. McCarry proceeded to go over the air quality

trends in Hamilton, and their relation to public health. Dr. Mcarry outlined the findings from the mobile air quality study and some of the recommendations that stem from the investigation.

The Board asked questions of Dr. McCarry, with respect to the data that was presented, and inquired what the City can do to continue to promote better air quality within the City.
