Next Steps and Inspiration

- Focus on developing a **minimum grid** of All Ages & Abilities (AAA) cycling infrastructure
- Identify **priority network gaps** and opportunities to upgrade existing facilities to meet AAA standards
- Increased **annual infrastructure funding** to implement Cycling Master Plan
- Enforcement of the **1m passing law**, replicating the work done in Ottawa, Guelph and other communities using radar device
- Work with police to launch Project 529 in Hamilton to **reduce bike theft**
- Develop & share clear plan for **cycling accommodations** during LRT construction and for cycling connections to LRT stops
