5. COMMUNICATIONS (Item 5)

i. Virtual Collaborative Roundtable Event

Committee members reviewed an invitation from the Advisory Committee for Persons with Disabilities' Transportation Working Group to participate in a virtual collaborative roundtable event. The committee will send regrets as no members are available to attend the event.

ii. Introduction of Morgan Stahl, Director, Government Relations and Community Engagement, City of Hamilton

Morgan Stahl, the new Director of Government Relations and Community Engagement for the City of Hamilton, introduced herself to the Committee Against Racism.

6. DISCUSSION ITEMS (Item 10)

i. Implementation Action Plan - 2021 Work Plan (Item 10.1)

Committee members reviewed the 2021 Work Plan, which contains up to 8 committee priorities. Sub groups were created to develop action plans for some of the committee priorities.

Current Sub Group membership include:

Priority 1B- A. Law and M. Dei-Amoah; Priority 2A- G. Smith, S. Jacobs and P. Jeffrey; Priority 2B- Dei-Amoah; 3A -T. Qasim and P. Jeffrey and S. McWatt for committee priority 7. The 2021 work plan will remain a working document that staff and councillor will provide updates respecting committee priorities when available.

ii. Hamilton Anti-Racism Resource Centre Update (Item 10.2)

Staff updated that Lyndon George was appointed as Executive Director of the Hamilton Anti-Racism Resource Centre. Committee members discussed maintaining a working relationship with the Hamilton Anti-Racism Resource Centre. M. Dei-Amoah, as chair, to invite Lyndon George to a future committee meeting.

iii. Update on Equity Diversity and Inclusion Framework (Item 10.3)

Staff and Councillor Nann provided an updated that Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Framework was approved at the General Issues Committee meeting on September 22, 2021 and will be ratified by council on September 29, 2021. Additional information on the Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Framework initiatives and video of the General Issues Committee presentation is available on the City's website. iv. All Advisory Committee Event- Follow up (Item 10.4)

Councillor Nann provided an update that the No Hate in the Hammer initiative will be launching a virtual speaker series on October 6, 2021, at 4:30pm.
