

Community Safety and Well-Being Plan Framework



Response to reports of domestic violence by Police Services

Creation of multi-disciplinary team to follow up on reports of domestic violence and ensure case continuity with referrals to appropriate community supports

Family and parenting resources to support healthy relationships and reduce conflict in the home

System mapping of existing pathways to safety to identify areas of needs and inefficiencies in existing services and supports for victims of abuse

Family and intimate partner violence education and awareness campaign





Moving to Action

- Need for sustainable governance model to support implementation, call out to partners and community to form action tables
- Opportunities for action will explored, prioritized and supporting implementation plans developed
