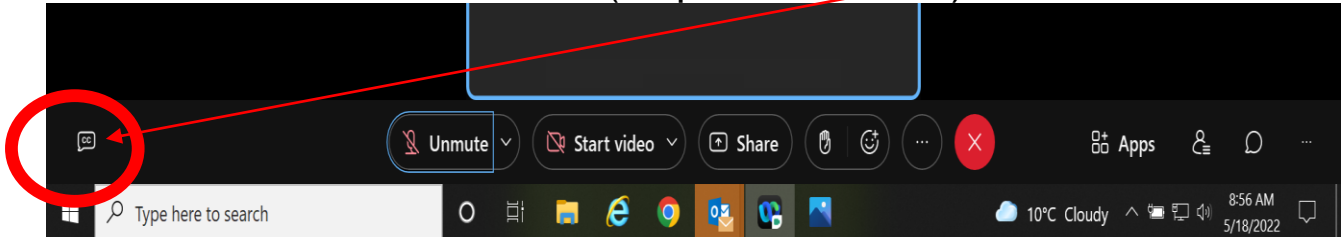
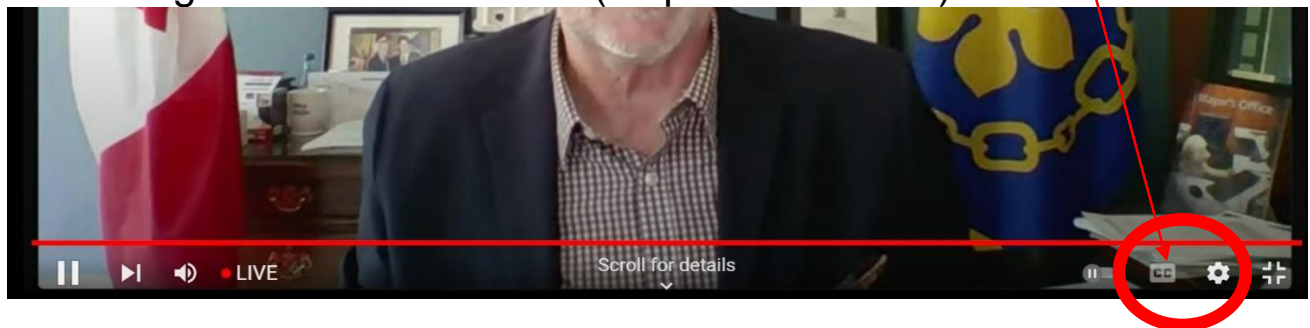


Illustration 'B' (Viewer on YouTube)
