## 5.2 Climate Change Office Staffing Updates and Community Climate Change Advisory Committee – Lynda Lukasik

Introduction of Lynda Lukasik, Director, Office of Climate Change Initiatives. The City of Hamilton has been working to develop a climate action strategy. Council has approved that strategy end of 2022. Two substantial components are Community Energy & Emissions Plan (CEEP) and Climate Change Impact Adaptation Plan (CCIAP). The City is moving forward with implementation and will bring details on how that is happening in a future DILG Agenda.

Update on Community Climate Change Advisory Committee - There is a Draft Terms of Reference going to the GIC meeting on Jan 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

## 5.3 Bill 109 and 23 Response – Anita Fabac

Bill 109: The earliest the Legislation will be tabled is approximately February 2023. The City's plan is to continue to proceed with those processes and the implementation that has been put in place, recognizing that fee refunds may not be required. Report

Bill 23: City is preparing to send recommendations to the Planning Committee on January 31st, 2023 (tentatively). More will be shared at a future meeting.

## 5.4 Next Wave of Development Terms of Reference Documents for the new Application Process – Anita Fabac

Council approved Phase 1 Terms of Reference (TOR). The City is currently using and applying these TOR. Starting to embark on Phase 2 process as well and undertaking further consultation on the interim Phase 1.

Targeting to bring something to Council at the end of 2023 so DILG will certainly be consulted. Similarly, to Phase 1, the documents will be posted to Engage Hamilton website providing an opportunity for dialogue and comments to be submitted there.

## 5.5 Residential Zoning Low Density Residential Zones – Steve Robichaud

Update to parking standards is under consultation. City is also in the process of doing the review of the secondary plans to identify which amendments are required to advance the completion of work to the balance of the city.

There are other technical amendments that are being investigated by the Planning division.
