#### 4. COMMUNICATIONS (Item 5)

(i) Councillor Cameron Kroetsch addresses the Committee regarding Gore Park (Item 5.1)

Councillor Kroetsch addressed Committee respecting Gore Park and the Cenotaph. Committee members advised that the current location of the Cenotaph in Gore Park is important because of its visibility to the public and its reflection of the City's military history.

(ii) Hamilton Conservation Authority Day Passes for Veterans (5.2)

Shane Drew Battersby addressed committee to speak to the feasibility of a free Day-Use Admission to the Hamilton Conservation Authority Sites for veterans and serving personnel. The Committee supports this initiative and Mike Rehill will write a letter to the Hamilton Conservation Authority.

(iii) Request for use of Gore Park (5.3)

Chris Redford reports the Grand Orange Lodge of Ontario West has made a courtesy request to the Committee to hold a Remembrance service at the Cenotaph on April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023. They would need to submit a SEAT application, acquire insurance and pay the rental fee.
