Potential Cost Savings Opportunity 2: Bag Supply Math Changes

- Currently One-Time Event Registrations provide 2 Orange Bags and 1 Clear Bag per Participant.
- Moving forward One-Time Registrations will provide 1 Orange Bags per Participant & 1 Clear Bag per every 2 Participants.
- On-Going Registrations will remain at 20 Orange and 10 Clear Bags per Registration.



Potential Cost Savings Opportunity 2: Bag Supply Math Changes

85/126 Registrations were "One Time Event" Registrations / 66%, 41/126 were "Ongoing" Registrations / 34%



Potential Cost Savings Opportunity 2: Bag Supply Math Changes

The below math shows the cost savings for 66% (One-Time Event Registrations Only) of the bags used from 01.01.2023 to 08.09.2023

Bag Type	Cost under Current Math: One-Time Event Registrations	Cost under New Math: One Time Event Registrations
Orange Bags	\$5,486	\$3,627
Clear Bags	\$1,782	\$1,176
Total Bags	\$7,268	\$4,797

Total Savings: \$2,471



Team Up to Clean Up Program Costs with Savings Opportunities Implemented

\$17,506 total cost from 01.01.2023 to 08.09.2023

If both savings opportunities are implemented we can likely reduce the \$17,506 (this number will increase before the end of the year) by \$5,158.00.

Please note:

- There was an order placed last year for bags that did not arrive until January. Due to the late arrival, the cost is req'd to come out of the 2023 budget.
- A bag order was placed in the spring for 35 boxes of orange bags and 35 boxes of clear bags. However, they had overruns changing the cost significantly and unexpectedly.
