Ross Williams' appeal of the Director of Licensing's request made November 23, 2023, to refuse an application for a City of Hamilton Mobile Licence – Refreshment Vehicle Class A, Pursuant to Section 12.(1)(c)(vi) of the City of Hamilton Licensing By-law 07-170

At the hearing the Tribunal will decide whether or not to uphold the refusal, and/or to revoke, suspend or have conditions imposed on your business licence. Please be advised that in accordance with City of Hamilton *Licensing By-Law 07-170* (as amended) (By-law), the application for the above-noted licence is refused and a licence will not be issued.

Pursuant to Section 12.(1)(c)(vi), the Director of Licensing & By-law Services (Director), shall refuse to issue a licence when, in the opinion of the Director:

(2) the operation of the applicant's or licensee's business is not or will not be carried on in compliance with the law; or

#### Namely,

- 1. The Certificate of Zoning Verification and Property Report, Certificate No. 22-143700 ZR2, dated September 27, 2022, from the Zoning Section, indicated that the proposed food truck/refreshment vehicle is considered a structure, and is not permitted in the "E2" Zone of Hamilton Zoning By-law 05-200 as the "E2" Zone does not permit a restaurant.
- 2. A Notice of Zoning Compliance Review was served on September 29, 2023, providing the applicant the opportunity to comply by establishing legal non-conforming status either as a Refreshment Vehicle or Restaurant through a Zoning Compliance Review with the Zoning Section. Deadline to apply was set as November 1, 2023.
- 3. No further communication was received back from the applicant, nor was an application/documentation submitted to the Zoning Section for the Zoning Compliance Review by the deadline as set out.
