#### **Council Direction:**

At the September 13, 2011 General Issues Committee, staff were asked to report back to Council with an update on progress made in regard to the Pan Am Velodrome project and existing funding gap. Information Report CM10005(d) is meant to provide this update.

#### Information:

The Request for Proposal (RFP) issued by Toronto 2015 and Infrastructure Ontario on September 22, 2011 includes the stadium and proposed Velodrome in Hamilton, as well as the stadium at York University. Although the RFP has been released, given the current funding issues surrounding the Velodrome, the exact location of this venue was not noted. It is anticipated that the Velodrome location will be noted in an addendum following today's Hamilton City Council decision.

#### Update on the Investigation of Flexible Options Regarding the Funding Shortfall

As directed by Council, staff are looking into the establishment of a "Campaign Cabinet" to work with outside individuals/organizations to develop a process to enable fundraising through private sector and public donations which will support the development and operations of the Velodrome. Mohawk College is prepared to support this fund raising cabinet, once established, by contributing expertise and a vehicle for collecting contributions. Mark Chamberlain of Trivaris, has agreed to be the "Campaign Cabinet" Chair.

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To date, staff are not aware of any significant external interest in or commitments to provide additional funding and/or donations in support of the development and operations of the Velodrome.

#### **Financial**

There are no updates in regard to the Financial capital costs or operating costs to provide at this time. The summary of the costs are detailed in both staff report CM10005(b) and CM10005(c) and are considered to be up-to-date. Since no additional financial contributions have been identified, the funding gap for the Velodrome remains at \$13 million to \$17.3 million.

In addition, if Council chooses to contribute more to the Velodrome, every \$5 million in debt financing would cost \$480,000 in annual debt charges and represent about a 0.1% or \$2.80 impact on property taxes for the average residential property.

Debt financing the entire funding shortfall i.e. \$13 million to \$17.3 million would have a residential tax impact of 0.19% or \$5.23 to 0.25% or \$6.97 per household.

Mohawk College was approached regarding the possibility of increasing their capital contribution to the Velodrome by \$2 million (for a total of \$4 million). At this point Mohawk is not in a position to contribute additional funds towards the construction of the Velodrome nor assume responsibility for its construction or operation.

#### **Update on Discussions with Toronto 2015 and Infrastructure Ontario**

At the time of the writing of this report, staff have not received an update from Toronto 2015. We anticipate an update from Ian Troop, CEO of Toronto 2015, will be available when this report is received.

#### **Update on the Proposed Partnership with Mohawk College**

Subsequent to the September 13, 2011 General Issues Committee meeting information report (CM10005(c)), City staff have met with Mohawk College to work on draft terms of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the use and operation of the Velodrome (Appendix A to Report CM10005(d)) and draft terms of a lease agreement. (Appendix B to Report CM10005(d)). The documents provide a summary of the work completed to date. A few issues are still outstanding and both parties are committed to meet over the next three to four weeks to resolve any outstanding issues. Final documents would subsequently be provided to Council for approval.

#### **Update on the Partnership with the Canadian Cycling Association**

There are no updates in regards to the partnership between the City of Hamilton and the Canadian Cycling Association at this time.
