10.3 Region of Halton Discussions for Processing of Source Separated Organics

Whereas, the City of Hamilton's Central Composting Facility has been processing Source Separated Organics from the Region of Halton for the past four (4) years;

And Whereas, the City of Hamilton has been receiving revenue for the processing of Source Separate Organics from the Region of Halton;

And Whereas, the City of Hamilton Public Works Committee directed staff at its February 7, 2011 meeting to determine ways to manage capacity and keep revenues for composting Source Separated Organics at the Central Composting Facility;

And Whereas, Halton Regional Council at its meeting of April 18, 2012 accepted report PW-33-12 that recommended "That Council authorize staff to initiate discussions with the City of Hamilton for the processing of Source Separated Organic Waste at the City of Hamilton's Centralized Composting Facility";

Therefore Be It Resolved, that the General Manager of Public Works, or his designate(s) be authorized and directed to enter into discussions with staff from the Region of Halton for the purpose of continued Source Separated Organics processing while maintaining capacity for the residents of the City of Hamilton and to report back to the Public Works Committee on the outcome and possible recommendations resulting from those discussions.
