On behalf of the McMaster Engineering Society, we, the organizers for the 2012 McMaster Engineering Bus Pull, would like to formally request the use of a full sized Hamilton Street Railway (HSR) city bus, along with operator, for Friday, September 7th, 2012.

For over twenty years, McMaster Engineering has facilitated the Bus Pull as an Orientation Week event to raise money for Cystic Fibrosis Canada. The first year Engineering students are pull the full-sized HSR bus downtown, with upper year students helping along the way. This event raises over \$1,500, annually and we are eagerly looking forward to continuing the tradition.
