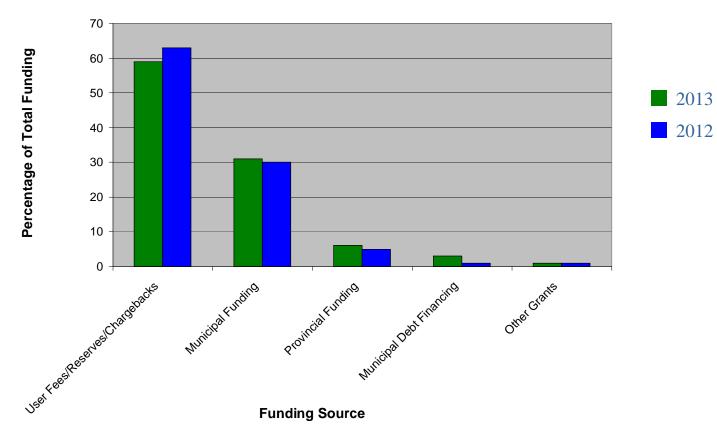

Funding Comparison 2013 vs 2012



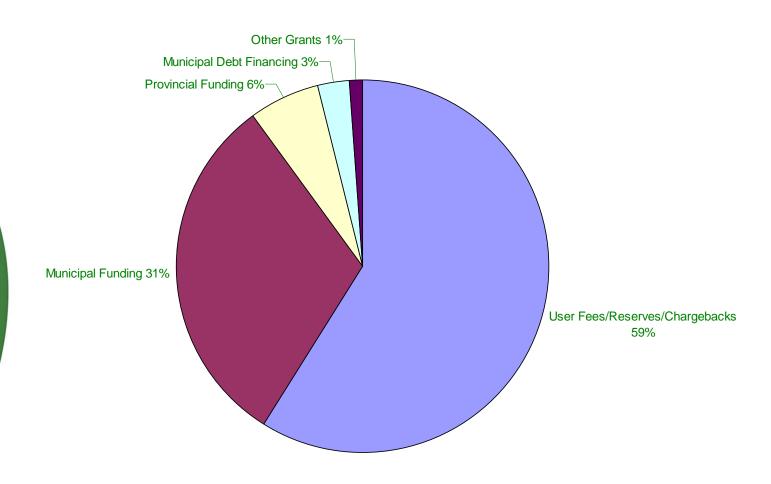

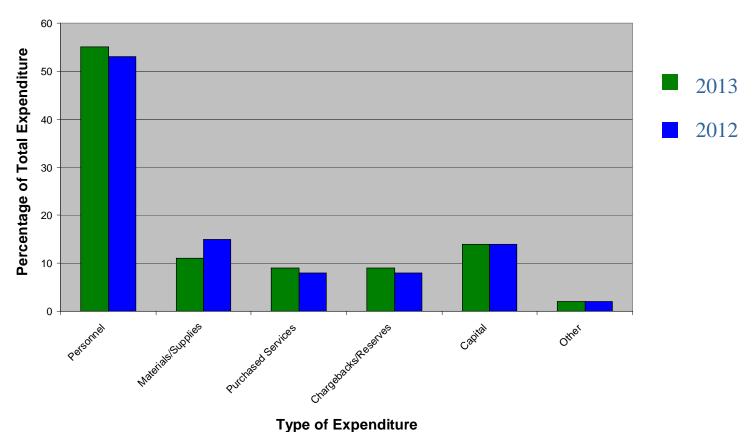
Funding by source 2013
