To Amend By-law No. 01-215 Being a By-law To Regulate Traffic

AND WHEREAS on the 18th day of September, 2001, the Council of the City of Hamilton enacted By-law No. 01-215 to regulate traffic;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to amend By-law No. 01-215.

 Burkholder Dr. Westbound East 25th St."

and by removing from Section "E" (Hamilton) thereof the following items, namely:

"Shade Forest Trail Northbound Alessio Dr.
Shade Forest Trail Southbound Summerwind Dr
Cedarwood Cres. Southbound Sabrina Blvd.
Summerberry Way Northbound Sabrina Blvd."
