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Council Direction:

On December 14, 2011, Council approved Report (FCS11073(a)) which directed staff to review a process where departments will report on the status of the Capital Work-in-Progress (WIP) projects to their respective Standing Committees. As a result of this Council direction and consistent with the Capital Status and Closing Policy, this report includes the status of active capital projects as of June 30th, 2013 for the Public Health Services Department. Capital project closings will remain with the Capital Budgets Section of the Financial Planning and Policy Division and be reported through a Capital Closing Report.

Information:

This report presents the capital projects' status for the Public Health Services Department, and is based on actual and committed expenditures to June 30th, 2013.

Appendix A further reflects the Tax Supported capital status of each project. As of June 30th, 2013, the life-to-date budget for active projects totals \$14.6 million (4 projects) of which \$2.9 million or 19.5% is spent or committed.

The percentage of completion, as of June 30th, 2013, is similar to the same period in 2012, achieving a slightly lower completion rate. The bulk of the capital projects within Public Health relate to the McMaster Health Campus which is currently on target and within expectations.

The September 30th, 2013 capital projects' status report for Public Health Services will be brought forward in the fall of 2013.
