## **BACKGROUND:**

On April 15, 2013, the "Centre Mall Crime Prevention Centre Relocation: to 460 Barton Street East, Hamilton" Board Report discussed the potential closing and relocation of the Concession Street CPC, when the lease expires on October 31, 2014. Further to this report and in response to inquiries by Hamilton City Council, the Police Service will continue to work with community stakeholders, including the Concession Street BIA and Ward Councillors to examine alternative cost effective locations for a Community Policing Centre in this area. These discussions have already commenced and will continue over the next 18 months. If an alternative location is not found, a lease for the present location will need to be negotiated.
