Kindly be advised that I have been retained by Ayman Mikhael, now the owner of 2142472 Ontario Ltd.

I am delivering this correspondence to you on an urgent basis with a request that I be granted permission by the Committee Chair to appear before your Committee at its October 8, 2013 meeting, at such time that is convenient to the Committee to make a brief presentation.

The above noted locations have a difficult and problematic history under the previous ownership. My client, Ayman Mikhael, has taken over ownership of these locations and has expended significant sums of money in order to "clean-up" these operations and bring them into compliance with the City's conditions. However, in this process, my client was not able to file applications for subsidies within the City's required timelines, a late filing was made and my client has been denied subsidies for all four locations. This is having a profound impact upon my client's ability to move forward with the proper operation of these facilities. It has been pointed out to my client that he cannot again qualify for subsidy applications for a period of 24 months. In the circumstances, this appears unfair and unduly harsh and I wish to address the Committee as soon as possible to appeal this result.
