Council Direction:

Council has directed staff to report on the use of Sections 4.10 and 4.11 of the Procurement Policy on a quarterly basis.

Information:

This report is issued quarterly in accordance with the Procurement Policy. This report details the procurement of goods and/or services during emergency situations and those detailed in Section 4.11 – Non-competitive Procurements for the third quarter 2013.

The Policy for Non-competitive Procurements is used in narrowly defined circumstances where it is justified that the policies for the general acquisition process could not be followed. The "Request to Use the Non-competitive Procurements/Emergency Reporting Form" is completed by the Client Department and approved by the General Manager.

During the third quarter of 2013, there were 76 purchases totalling \$3,768,800 which were processed through the use of approved Policy 10 and 11. These are summarized in Appendix 'A' to report FCS13014(b).

The breakdown is as follows:

- Six purchases totalling \$395,324 were issued under Policy 10, as "Emergency" purchases, whereby goods and services were acquired by the most expedient and economical means. The following purchase represents the largest dollar amount in this category:
 - o Purchase order 71858 for \$198,860 was issued to McCanical Inc. Plant Operations has sustained considerable wear and operational problems in the Low Lift Pumping Station due to the infestation of Zebra mussels. The infestation has been attributed to the extended construction period (October 2010 to October 2012) during which time the chlorination of the intake pipes was not possible, as a result of on-going capital works. The subsequent re-commissioning of the chlorination system and introduction of flow in the pipes resulted in an inordinate quantity of Zebra mussels being released and impacting the raw water travelling screens at the The travelling screens are designed to intercept suspended station. foreign material, in order to protect the downstream pumps from damage. The hardness and sharp edges of the Zebra mussels have damaged the travelling screens and thereby reduced their effectiveness and ability for removal, increasing the risk potential to the newly refurbished water supply pumps. This purchase order was issued to provide labour, equipment and materials necessary to complete emergency repair to the Low Lift Pumping Station travelling screen number 2.
- 70 purchases totalling \$3,373,475 were identified as "Single Source" purchases whereby a particular vendor was recommended because it was more cost-effective or beneficial to the City. The following purchases represent the largest dollar amount in this category:
 - O Purchase order 71852 for \$175,000 was issued to Karrys Bros. Limited for the supply and delivery of wholesale foods, confectionary, hot beverages for resale to all City concessions and Sackville Seniors Centre. The vendor also provides a rebate structure and free equipment installation. Recreation Food Services will be following a formal procurement process for this requirement within 6 months of this approval.
 - Purchase order 71877 for \$167,000 was issued to CSDC Systems Inc. There are a number of Divisions within the Planning and Economic Development Department that are using the AMANDA system to automate their business processes and workflows. There was a recognized need to consolidate applications and to adopt one standard across the Divisions. Using one common AMANDA platform across the different Divisions will allow the Planning and Economic Development Department to standardize

and streamline common elements seamlessly. AMANDA copyrights are exclusive to CSDC Systems Inc. and the purchase order issued will purchase software and licenses and to retain professional services from CSDC Systems Inc.

- Purchase order 71287 for \$152,000 was issued to Hamilton Region Conservation Authority. Hamilton Region Conservation Authority is the only provider to deliver environmental data collected in the field from existing monitoring equipment and/or site specific temporary field data collection equipment including, but not limited to, stream flow, rainfall, ground water, snow pack, general climate, water quality data and trend/interpretive analysis thereof. Provision of services for field inspection and site inspection related to flooding, erosion, water quality sample collection, drainage analysis, and Hamilton's Drinking Water System Monitoring Well Inspection and Reporting to the Ministry of Environment. This purchase order is issued for services over approximately a two year period.
- Purchase order 71382 for \$150,000 was issued to York Environmental Solutions LP to undertake demolition and associated demolition works at City Motor Motel at 55 Queenston Road, Hamilton.

Requests for Quotations, Tenders and Proposals are issued to encourage the competitive bidding process with objective and equitable treatment of all vendors, in accordance with the Procurement Policy approved by Council.
