Legal: The Municipal Act 2001, Sections 204-215 govern BIAs. Section (204), Subsection (3) stipulates, "A Board of Management shall be composed of, (a) one or more Directors appointed directly by the municipality; and (b) the remaining Directors selected by a vote of the membership of the improvement area and appointed by the municipality". Section 204 Subsection (12) stipulates, "....if a vacancy occurs for any cause, the municipality may appoint a person to fill the vacancy for the unexpired portion of the term and the appointed person is not required to be a member of the improvement area".

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND (Chronology of events)

The Board of Management of the Westdale Village BIA elected Anne Campagna and John Garbe at its meeting held January 16, 2013. The Board of Management at the meeting also received the resignation of Jennifer Rowat.

The appointment of Anne Campagna and John Garbe and the removal of Jennifer Rowat brings the number of Board members of the Westdale Village BIA's Board of Management to 9, not including the Ward Councillor.
