






### REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

- NGTA EA Study recommendations look at medium term solutions and future study will be needed to address 2031 planning horizon, elements may include:
  - Longer planning horizon, eg. to 2041 to meet new Provincial Projections
  - Expanded study area geography and transportation problems/opportunities
  - Opportunities to shift transportation modes and increased integration of non-roadway service providers



### REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

- Inter-Municipal Collaboration needed to present a unified vision for economic success of NGTA region to Provincial and Federal governments
  - Meetings initiated in December 2012 with Regions of Halton, Niagara, Peel and Waterloo, City of Burlington and City of Hamilton
  - Inter-Regional Strategic Economic Logistics Corridors and Gateway Connections Municipal Caucus



## **REPORT HIGHLIGHTS**

- Update of the City's Goods Movement Strategy recommended to better understand needs for Hamilton and potential synergies or connections from the NGTA recommendations
- City of Hamilton Transportation Master Plan update will be a resource
- Big Move is a related initiative

### RECOMMENDATIONS

- a) Staff be directed to participate in future studies that will be required for NGTA Corridor Planning and EA Phase 1 Study
- b) The Hamilton 2005 Goods Movement Study be updated and included as part of the 2014 budget
- c) Staff be directed to participate in the Inter-regional Strategic Economic Logistics and Gateway Connections Municipal Caucus
