RECOMMENDATION

That in accordance with the City of Hamilton's Procurement Policy #14 - Standardization, ITERIS brand long distance, temporary conditions and expressway monitoring vehicle detection systems and software single source supplier be changed from AE Traffic Technologies Ltd. to The Get Go Inc. (GGI Road and Traffic).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Council at its meeting of October 9, 2013, approved Report 13-012 of the Public Works Committee as presented, authorizing the Traffic Operations and Engineering Section to purchase as a standard, the ITERIS brand long distance, temporary conditions and expressway monitoring vehicle detection systems and software; distributed by AE Traffic Technologies Ltd. The City has received a letter from the manufacturer of the ITERIS products stating that the sole authorized distributor for the ITERIS product line in the Provinces of Ontario, Quebec, and the Maritimes is now The Get Go Inc. (GGI Road and Traffic). It is recommended that the City now purchase the ITERIS brand detection systems and software from the single source supplier identified by the manufacturer.

Alternatives for Consideration - N/A

FINANCIAL - STAFFING - LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

Financial: There are no financial implications. **Staffing:** There are no staffing implications.

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Legal: The installation and operation of traffic control devices is dictated by the Highway Traffic Act and the Municipal Act. The use of the defined products will assist in maintaining a traffic infrastructure that meets all legal requirements.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Based on testing, staff had concluded that ITERIS brand long distance, temporary conditions and expressway monitoring vehicle detection products have unmatched capabilities for long distance, temporary conditions and expressway monitoring applications. The ITERIS line of products is also fully compatible with technology and equipment currently used in the City. For these reasons Traffic Operations and Engineering has recommended that the ITERIS brand long distance, temporary conditions and expressway monitoring vehicle detection systems be designated as a standard.

It is recommended that the City purchase the ITERIS brand detection systems and software from The Get Go Inc. (GGI Road and Traffic), the new single source supplier identified by the manufacturer.
