Reason(s) for delegation request: : *	The Neighbourhood Action Strategy (NAS) and Public Health Services (PHS) in collaboration with McMaster School of Nursing have been facilitating photovoice projects in the community since 2012. Photovoice was the method chosen to engage children/youth and give them a voice as part of the Neighbourhood Action Strategy. Photovoice is an excellent way of capturing people's stories. Westview School, located in Rolston Neighbourhood in Ward 8 completed a Photovoice project in February 2014. Through a massive snowstorm and bitter cold, 12 grade 7 students along with a teacher and EA worked to produce maps, photos and ideas for community change. At the conclusion of the project they presented their findings to their school and then wondered, "Can we take this to City Hall to share with the Mayor and our City Councillor?" The Westview students and teacher would like to share with Council their 15 minute presentation, including a vision for Rolston, photos of what they believe are priorities for change.
