Overview

- The owner of 15 Cottrill Street has applied to permanently close and purchase the public unassumed alleyway which abuts the side of the applicant's property to the south
- The applicant has been maintaining this alleyway and would like to integrate it into their property to further improve the aesthetics and functionality



Notification to Neighbouring Property Owners

- Notice was provided to the owners of the 124 properties within a 121.9 metre (400') radius of the Subject Lands
- There were 4 responses in support of the application
- There were no responses in opposition of the application
 - There are two abutting property owners who were asked if they had any interest in purchasing any portion of the Subject Lands – neither property owner expressed any interest in purchasing any part of the alleyway

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


Aerial Drawing Representing Proposed Closure and Sale
