## To Amend By-law No. 01-215, a By-law to Regulate Traffic

**WHEREAS** Council enacted a by-law to regulate traffic being City of Hamilton By-law No. 01-215;

**AND WHEREAS** this By-law provides for amendments with respect to permits authorizing excess weight or dimensions and signs and similar devices on bridges;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

- 1. By-law No. 01-215 is amended by adding the following new section 4.1 after section 4:
  - 4.1 A police officer or Municipal Law Enforcement Officer appointed to enforce the provisions of this By-law, upon observing an object or vehicle on or near a highway in contravention of this By-law, may cause such object or vehicle to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for the removal, care and storage of a vehicle, if any, are a lien upon the vehicle, which may be enforced in the manner provided by the *Repair and Storage Liens Act*.
- 2. Section 55 of By-law No. 01-215 is amended by adding the following new subsection 55(5.1) after subsection 55(5):
  - 55(5.1) No person shall move upon a highway a vehicle, load, object or structure in excess of the weight or dimensions prescribed by the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u> without an authorizing permit.

3.	By-law No. 01-215 is amended by adding the following new section 62.1 after section			
	62.1(a)	No person shall display above sign or similar device.	person shall display above, on or under a City bridge over a highway any gn or similar device.	
	(b)	(b) Subsection 62.1 does not apply to an authorized sign or an official sign.
