10.2 Sidewalk Construction along the south portion of Acadia Drive and on both sides of Upper Sherman Avenue between Rymal Road East and Stonechurch Road

Whereas there are no continuous, non-interrupted sidewalks along the south portion of Acadia Drive and on both sides of Upper Sherman Avenue between Rymal Road East and Stonechurch Road; and

Whereas 2000 students and staff from St. Jean de Brebéuf Catholic Secondary School, and members of the public, use these roads every day; and

Whereas the lack of sidewalks creates serious safety issues; and

Whereas in the winter months students and staff are forced to walk on the road, and

Whereas over 500 students and staff have signed the attached petition calling for the construction of sidewalks in this area;

Therefore be it resolved:

That staff be directed to report to the Public Works Committee on the measures which can be taken to construct sidewalks along the south portion of Acadia Drive and on both sides of Upper Sherman Avenue between Rymal Road East and Stonechurch Road, that meet the City's Pedestrian Mobility Plan; and

That the report include the timeline involved in constructing sidewalks so that safety concerns can be addressed.
