For your information, please note that on June 16, 2014 Enbridge filed its Updated Engineering Assessment and Watercourse Crossing Management Plan, in compliance with Conditions 9 and 18 respectively of NEB Order XO-E101-003-2014. The documents filed with the Updated Engineering Assessment also contain information that addresses condition 11 (hydrostatic pressure testing program) and condition 19 (plan to manage cracking features on Line 9 between Sarnia and Montreal terminals).
