CITY OF HAMILTON

To Amend By-law No. 07-170, a By-law to License and Regulate Various Businesses

WHEREAS Council enacted a by-law to license and regulate various businesses being City of Hamilton By-law No. 07-170;

AND WHEREAS this By-law provides for an amendment to Schedule 3 – Bed and Breakfasts, Hotels and Motels;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

- 1. Section 4 of Schedule 6 of By-law No. 07-170 is deleted and replaced by the following new section 4:
 - 4. When submitting an application for a licence under this Schedule, an applicant shall:
 - (a) upon first applying for a licence, submit a detailed premises plan, drawn to scale, of the bed and breakfast, hotel or motel that has been approved by the Issuer of Licences and the details of such premises plan shall include but are not limited to depicting the location, as applicable, of all buildings or other structures, parking areas and walkways on the property where the bed and breakfast, hotel or motel is located and all entrances/exits, beds, dining areas and entertainment areas in the bed and breakfast, hotel or motel;

- (b) upon first applying for a licence and every third year thereafter upon applying for a licence renewal, submit a certificate from the Electrical Safety Authority that shows the bed and breakfast, hotel or motel complies with the Ontario Electrical Safety Code;
- (c) upon first applying for a licence and every third year thereafter upon applying for a licence renewal, submit proof satisfactory to the Issuer of Licences that a fire inspection has been completed during the previous three years;
- (d) upon first applying for a licence and every third year thereafter upon applying for a licence renewal, submit a certificate of compliance under the Property Standards By-law.
- 2. This By-law comes into force on the day it is passed.
