Tenant Voter Turnout

- Connecting and networking with agencies including:
 - Aboriginal Advisory Committee Common interest to increase voter turnout; exercise rights of citizenship
 - Hamilton Legal Clinic explore potential common initiatives
 - Hamilton Civic League input from citizens on election issues
 - Social Planning and Research Council expanding voter sites;
 work with Neighbourhood PlanningTeam

Tenant Voter Turnout

- TAC reported to Emergency and Community Services on voter turnout and continues to advocate for this issue.
- TAC advocated for a pilot project voting station in multiresidential buildings
- Status: Complete

Tenant Access to City Hall

- Presentation from Call Center Representative provided feedback.
- Monitor the redevelopment of the City website provided input.
- Status: Complete

Proactive Enforcement/Rental Housing Licensing

TAC was involved in community discussions in 2013 and intend to be involved in any community discussions in 2014 and beyond.

Tenant Education and Rights

- Presentation by Matt Bowen on the Tenant Engagement Strategies, City Housing Hamilton - Complete
- TAC sponsorship support for the Riverdale tenant conference on October 6th, 2014 - Complete
- Established a relationship with Hamilton District Apartment Association to share information relating to landlord and tenant responsibilities. -Complete
- Presentation from Hamilton District Apartment Association encouraged
 TAC to support changes to the Multi Residential Tax Rate. In progress

Condo Conversions

TAC provided direct input to the development of the protocol for condo conversions regarding the 75% tenant approval rule (to ensure full and free consent of tenants)
