Pan Am Hamilton Event Information

Soccer

- Highest spectator attendance of all games
- 2015 July 11 to 26
- Expecting 10,000 to 20,000 spectators per game
- One ticket per day typically 2 games / day
- Games in the afternoon / evening
- Cultural events across city
- 3 official languages and multi-countries
- Demographics of spectators, athletes, dignitaries
- Numerous language and cultural opportunities



Emergency Planning Pan Am Risk Assessment - Provincial

- Provincial risk assessment for the Games
 - Hazardous material incident
 - Tornado
 - Critical infrastructure failure
 - Human health emergency



Emergency Planning Pan Am Risk Assessment - Local

Potential local Impacts for the Games

- Traffic and transportation incidents
- Severe weather

- Infection Control
- Food Safety
- Inside and outside the fence

Build the response on the foundation




Specific to Pan Am





Pan AM Tobacco Control PHS Highlights

Toronto Public Health submitted a Tobacco-Free Games policy

Hamilton Public Health Services' recommended these opportunities:

- 1. Toronto 2015 centralized communications / marketing re: Tobacco-Free Games (should the TFGP be adopted);
- 2. Additional temporary no smoking signage beyond fixed stadium installations;
- 3. A Tobacco Free Games Policy enforcement strategy
