Only location signs (which either names or identifies the property, occupant(s) or owner(s) or a business conducted on the property, or advertises a product or service(s) available upon the property, or conveys a message placed solely for guidance on the property) are permitted, provided they meet all requirements of the Ministry's *Corridor Signing Policy* and must obtain all municipal approvals.
