## **Council Direction:**

On December 14, 2011, Council approved Report FCS11073(a) which directed staff to review a process where departments will report on the status of the Capital Work-in-Progress projects to their respective Standing Committees. As a result of this Council direction, and consistent with the Capital Status and Closing Policy, this report includes the status of active capital projects as of September 30, 2014 for Corporate Services and the City Manager's Office. Capital project closings remain with the Capital Budgets section of the Financial Planning and Policy Division and are reported through the Capital Closing Report.

## Information:

This report presents the status of Corporate Services and the City Manager's Office Capital Projects based on actual and committed expenditures to September 30, 2014. Appendix "A" to Report FCS14060(a) reflects the capital status of each project by Division and consists of projects totalling \$18,967,375, of which \$10,871,784 or 57.3%, has been spent or committed as of September 30, 2014.
