Our elected officials acted with dignity, no one played politics. From an Argyll perspective Cpl. Cirillo received the same funeral that all Argylls receive.

As this is Geordie's last meeting as SA of Mayor on behalf of the HVC, Bob expressed their appreciation of his input and offered our standing invitation for him to attend in future. Staff will ensure Geordie receives an application for membership when they are available.
