Further to your telephone call this morning regarding our objection of the closing and sale of the alley off James Street North and my response of January 15<sup>th</sup> I wish to reiterate that the owners of the Right House, Hughson Centre, as well as 13-15 King Street East are opposed to this closure/sale.
