Decisions:

- 1) Gore Park Cenotaph add 'Korea' and 'Afghanistan' with dates 2001 2014 (carved)
- 2) Dundas Cenotaph add 'Korea' and 'Afghanistan' with dates (cast new bronze plaques)
- Stoney Creek Cenotaph add 'Afghanistan' with dates to north end of granite slab (carved)
- 4) Ancaster Cenotaph add 'Korea' and 'Afghanistan' with dates (cast new bronze plaques)
- 5) Glanbrook Cenotaph add 'Afghanistan' with dates (carved)
- 6) Eastlawn Cenotaph add 'Afghanistan' with dates (carved)

Based on the above, Therese will go ahead and get estimates to have the work done as well as contact the federal Cenotaph/Monument Restoration Program to see if the work qualifies for any funding. Once the estimates, etc are in hand, Therese will send the workplan for final vetting/approval by the committee - especially because there was some confusion over whether names should be added in the case where they are listed for the other wars and she wants to ensure it is done the way the HVC wishes.

Other items discussed that require follow-up:

- Mt Hope cenotaph: as requested, I will photograph and measure the sides of the cenotaph and send the info to you
- The flags at Mt Hope Rebecca to check with Public Works to see if they put flags up for Remembrance Day.
- Look into removing or severely cutting back the trees on the west side of the Stoney Creek cenotaph (at the request of the Stoney Creek Legion)
- Check Woodland Cemetery possibly a cenotaph to add to inventory
- Both the Dieppe cenotaph at the beach area and the Memorial at Bayfront Park are now looked after by parks – the veterans requested that they be looked after by the Tourism and Culture Division – Therese will follow up with Anna Bradford, Director of Tourism and Culture on how to proceed
