(i) City's Submission under the Government of Canada's "Canada 150" Community Infrastructure Program (3.1)

(Farr/Green)

Whereas, staff have confirmed a full St. Mark's rehabilitation project may be completed before the March 31, 2018 deadline and; therefore, smaller scale projects under the full scope are achievable;

Whereas, staff have confirmed that elements of an overall rehabilitation may be applied for rather than a full rehabilitation as per the Canada 150 application rules;

Whereas, staff have confirmed that St. Mark's has been utilized recently for community use (for example: Open Doors Hamilton and several Public Information Centres);

Whereas, in order to address a safety and preservation issue, the community voted through a Participatory Budget process to restore the roof of St. Marks and funds through the Ward 2 Area Rating Capital Reserve have been allocated toward this project; and,

Whereas, a full rehabilitation project scope for St. Mark's includes, but is not limited to, safety and preservation at a cost of \$960,000, as determined in our 2014 St. Mark's Council report;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- (a) That the capital project description respecting the rehabilitation for St. Mark's Church be amended to focus specifically on safety and preservation related work;
- (b) That \$400,000 of the Ward 2 Area Rating Capital Reserve, be allocated to offset the cost of \$960,000;
- (c) That the capital project for safety and preservation related rehabilitation for St. Mark's Church, in the amount of \$280,000, be added as Item 27 in the

City of Hamilton's submission to Federal Government for the Canada 150 Community Infrastructure Program; and,

(d) That the staff recommended submission of \$183,150 for the Renovation of the Central Memorial Recreation Centre Outdoor Space and Patio to accommodate persons with disabilities (shown as Item 11 of Appendix A to Report FCS15049), be removed from the Canada 150 Community Infrastructure submission.
