4.3 Veterans Place at Gore Park - Security

Inspector Mike Worster will update committee on a regular basis.

Bob will be meeting with Inspector Worster to make sure cameras are capturing all of Veterans' Place. Joey Coleman made contact with skateboarders association; Anna also reached out but has not yet heard back. Conservator is considering metal clips on the granite (on a trial basis) to further discourage skateboarding.

4.7 Afghanistan Memorial

Staff, with Keven Ellis of the North Wall Riders, are investigating the feasibility of an Afghanistan Memorial on City property.

Update: Anna posed the question to Public Works; their response was to ask whether the committee would consider location across from Stoney Creek Cenotaph or, alternately, a cemetery location. Committee supports location across from Stoney Creek Cenotaph. Anna will now take this to the Councillor and continue following up.

4.9 Status of City's Volunteer Advisory Committees

Direction from Council as recommended in Report CM15007 *Review of the City of Hamilton's Advisory Committees* - review existing Terms of Reference with any changes being approved by their respective Standing Committee.

It was also noted specific to the Hamilton Veterans Committee:

 Membership – committee members noted that they would benefit from expanding the membership to include representatives of veteran related agencies. Staff (Clerks) therefore suggest that a

- revised membership listing be drafted in consultation with staff liaisons prior to the next recruitment period in order to facilitate these additions.
- Meeting Frequency the committee noted that they would prefer to meet less frequently during the majority of the year (e.g. every two months), with the option to meet more frequently during the months leading up to annual events.

Staff Liaisons are recommending that the current approved membership be amended to include a minimum of 1 member at large with a maximum of 3 members at large that meet the approved member at large criteria.

(Steckham / Tompkins) Motion:

That the membership of the Hamilton Veterans Committee be revised to include a minimum of 1 member at large with a maximum of 3 members at large that meet the approved member at large criteria.

4.11 Military Personnel Recognition revisions to Facility Naming Policy Update: Adrienne Kupchanko, Policy and Program Analyst, and Jennifer DiDomenico, Manager of Policy and Programs, Strategic Planning Adrienne and Jennifer presented on what they have reported to date to the Facility Naming Sub-committee. Staff recommendation is that military personnel conform to existing Facility Naming Policy, Clause 4a. If they do not meet the criteria of the Policy, Clause 4a that other City programs are taken advantage of for requests to honour military personnel. The HVC noted that very few military personnel would meet the requirements of the Policy, Clause 4a and requested clarification of the other programs available. Report is recommending designating places of honour with commemorative pavers, plaques, etc.

Wording in the presentation identifies honouring *fallen* military personnel; HVC requested that the word *fallen* be removed as this implies that requests would only be considered for those killed in action/deceased.
