THE AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS ADVISORY COMMITTEE PRESENTS REPORT 15-002 AND RESPECTFULLY RECOMMENDS:

(a) CHANGES TO THE AGENDA (Item 1)

The Committee Clerk advised of the following change to the agenda:

(i) January 15, 2015 (Item 3.1)

The Minutes of the January 15, 2015 Agriculture and Rural Affairs Advisory Committee meeting were approved, as presented.

(d) PRESENTATIONS (Item 7)

(i) Mary Ellen Prange, Health Promotion Specialist, and Elizabeth Smith, Public Health Dietician, respecting the City's Food Strategy (Item 7.1)

Ms. Mary Ellen Prange, Health Promotion Specialist, and Ms. Elizabeth Smith, Public Health Dietician, provided the Committee with information about the City's Food Strategy.

Ms. Prange distributed a handout entitled "Love your City – It Feeds Us". A copy of the handout has been retained for the official record. Ms. Prange provided an overview of the document and outlined what the City's visions and goals are in creating a Food Strategy.

Ms. Prange and Ms. Smith asked Committee members for their feedback and suggestions on the draft policy.

The presentation respecting the City's Food Strategy, was received.

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(ii) Sue Gilpin, Superintendent, Environmental Services, Public Works Department, respecting Phragmites Control (Item 7.2)

Ms. Sue Gilpin, Superintendent, Environmental Services, Public Works Department, provided the Committee with an update respecting Phragmites Control.

Ms. Gilpin distributed a document entitled, "Smart Practices for Controlling Invasive Phragmites in Ontario's Roadside Ditches". A copy of the document has been retained for the official record.

Mr. Brian Morris, Business Development Consultant, provided the Committee with information respecting the Development of the Agriculture Program - City Enrichment Fund.

Mr. Morris distributed a document entitled, "City Enrichment Fund Agriculture Program – Guidelines". A copy of the document has been retained for the official record.

Mr. Morris provided information to the Committee regarding the objectives of the program, the eligibility criteria and the application process.

The update from Brian Morris, Business Development Consultant, respecting the Development of the Agriculture Program - City Enrichment Fund, was received.

(ii) Update from Joanne Hickey-Evans, Manager, Policy Planning and Zoning By-law Reform respecting the Rural Zoning By-law (Item 8.2)

Ms. Joanne Hickey-Evans, Manager, Policy Planning and Zoning By-law Reform, provided the Committee with information respecting the Rural Zoning By-law.

The new Rural Zoning By-law was approved by Council in July of this year. Appeals have been received and the City is awaiting a hearing date from the Ontario Municipal Board to consider the matter.

The Update from Joanne Hickey-Evans, Manager, Policy Planning and Zoning By-law Reform respecting the Rural Zoning By-law, was received.

(f) GENERAL INFORMATION/OTHER BUSINESS (Item 11)

(i) Update on the Greenbelt Consultation Process (Added Item 11.1)

Ms. Joanne Hickey-Evans, Manager, Policy Planning and Zoning By-law Reform, provided the Committee with an update respecting the Greenbelt Consultation Process.

With the aid of display boards, Ms. Hickey-Evans showed a map to the Committee of the lands designated in the City as being part of the Greenbelt.

Ms. Hickey-Evans stated that the City is holding public meetings for citizens to comment on the Greenbelt Review. The province is currently undertaking the Greenbelt Review and asking for input. A report outlining what was heard during the consultation process will be going to the Planning Committee later this year.

The update from Joanne Hickey-Evans, Manager, Policy Planning and Zoning By-law Reform, respecting the Greenbelt Consultation Process, was received.
