“West Hamilton a village and its Church”

On page 123 of the above book, a picture is shown of the installation of sewers on Royal Avenue and Leland dated 1932.

The services, i.e. water and sewage is about 85 years old. This system was designed for its time, and has never been updated.

As a result, one must look at the infra-structure. This system was designed for individual houses, not large concentrations of densely populated buildings.
