#### FINANCIAL - STAFFING - LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

for any part of the Operating Budget.

At its Annual General Meeting on November 3, 2015, the Downtown Hamilton BIA Board of Management presented its proposed Budget for 2016. The process followed to adopt the Downtown Hamilton BIA's budget was in accordance with the BIA's procedure By-law.
