




Introduction


From March 30 until July 31, 2015, the City of Hamilton launched an online survey to support the "Our Future Hamilton: Communities in Conversation" project engagement. 554 residents completed the survey from all the Wards in Hamilton. Below is a summary of the demographics of survey respondents.

Introduction

A second online survey supporting "Our Future Hamilton: Communities in Conversation" was available to residents from October 26 until November 30, 2015. The survey was available in both English and French. 671 Hamilton residents completed the online survey; 617 surveys were submitted in English and 54 surveys were submitted in French. Survey respondents had the option to submit their postal code in addition to their survey responses. A summary of geographic distribution of survey respondents by ward is shown below.
