For fifty-nine years we have resided on
the "Taylor Survey" located on the Old Brock Rd.
at Hwy #5. This has grown into a fair-sized
residential area. The roads here are deplorable!!!

The Old Brock Rd. has never been resurfaced in
all of those 59 yrs - it consists of filled in
pot holes and bumps. We could cross over at
Spencer Valley School to the "new" Brock Rd, but
from there to the Greensville intersection in the
village of Greensville, it too is getting in rough
condition as well.

In recent years Crooks Hollow road was
redefined and rebuilt out to Hwy 8. to attract
tourists + hikers etc. However the road from
there to the Greensville intersection was not
done and it is reverting to pot holes + gravel.

It seems the City of Hamilton has
forgotten Glamborough - but they have no
difficulty in getting the tax bill to us!
