To Amend By-law No. 01-215, a By-law to Regulate Traffic

WHEREAS Council enacted a by-law to Regulate Traffic being City of Hamilton By-law No. 01-215;

AND WHEREAS this By-law amends By-law No. 01-215 by adding Schedule 32 listing pedestrian crossovers;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

- 1. Section 1 of By-Law No. 01-215 is amended by adding following new definition:
 - (u.1) "pedestrian crossover" means any portion of a roadway distinctly indicated for pedestrian crossing by signs on the highway and lines or other markings on the surface of the roadway as may be prescribed by the *Highway Traffic Act* regulations and as designated in Schedule 32 (Pedestrian Crossovers);
- 2. Section 6 of By-law No. 01-215 is deleted and replaced with the following new section 6:
 - 6. The schedules attached to this By-law, numbered 1 to 34 both inclusive, are included in and form part of this By-law.
- 3. By-law No. 01-215 is amended by adding Schedule 34 (Pedestrian Crossovers) attached to this By-law as Appendix A.
