

**CITY OF HAMILTON**

**BY-LAW NO. 16-155**

**Respecting:**

**Removal of Part Lot Control  
Block 112 of Registered Plan No. 62M-1050**

**WHEREAS** the sub-section 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

**AND WHEREAS** sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

“(7) **Designation of lands not subject to part lot control.** -- Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law.”

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, for the purpose of creating one (1) lot for commercial purposes, shown as Part 1, and one (1) lot for residential purposes, shown as Part 2, on deposited Reference Plan 62R-20295, including:

Block 112, Registered Plan No. 62M-1050, in the City of Hamilton

2. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
3. This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2018.
