Dear Chair and Committee Members:

We are respectfully requesting that Committee seriously consider a review of our Area Rating system at your next Committee meeting scheduled for August 10th.

We are of the opinion that hundreds, if not THOUSANDS, of residences, commercial and industrial business located within our **urban** boundaries have a R**ural levy** for Fire. For those that aren't aware, rural fire levy is 50% of the urban fire levy (rate / thousand \$ assessment). also about 5x those of transit

There appears to be absolutely no consistency or rationale applied throughout the city which is completely inequitable. The result has placed even more pressure on our members who are taxed as urban/urban residential under our Area Rating system. Fire levies range anywhere from 25% to 150% more than our Transit levies so a review of this levy, prior to Transit, is in our opinion more pressing.
