Project Title	Ancaster Aquatic Centre Renovation
Project Description	<p>The Ancaster Aquatic Centre has provided recreational programming to the community for the past 40 years. There have been minor upgrades completed over the years; however, the facility has come to a time where it is necessary to renovate in order to bring its amenities up to current accessibility standards (AODA).</p> <p>The scope of work includes the reconfiguration of the existing change room space (currently male/female) to new male, female, and universal change rooms. Scope also includes the addition of a meeting room; plumbing and HVAC changes to in order to accommodate the redesign. The existing elevator will also be upgraded in order to bring it up to current standards including AODA compliance. There is no addition to the existing footprint.</p> <p>The newly renovated facility will be a fully accessible indoor pool and recreation centre that groups, individuals, and families will enjoy for years to come.</p>
