The Committee Clerk advised of the following changes to the agenda:

The agenda for the August 11, 2016 meeting of the Hamilton Port Authority – City of Hamilton Liaison Committee was approved, as amended.

(i) Land Use Plan Update (Item 3.1)

(d) DISCUSSION ITEMS (Item 8)

(i) Review of the Hamilton Port Authority – City of Hamilton Liaison Committee - Terms of Reference (Item 4.1)

The Composition was amended by changing the number of Members of Council from five to two and the total from (5) to (3) as follows:

Composition: The Mayor and five *two* Members of City Council (5) (3) Port Authority Board Chair, and two members (3)

The Support Staff complement was amended by adding the words "and other staff as needed" to read as follows:

Support Staff: City Manager and Port Authority Director and other staff as needed.

The first bullet of the Terms of Reference was amended by adding the words *"including climate change initiatives, non-residential tax growth and living wage jobs"* to read as follows:

• Ensuring that development on the *Hamilton Port Authority* lands is compatible with both the economic development of the port and the interest of the *City of Hamilton including climate change initiatives, non-residential tax growth and living wage jobs*;

All references in the Terms of Reference to the *City* and the *Port* were expanded to read the *City of Hamilton* and the *Hamilton Port Authority*.

For disposition of this matter refer to Item 2.
