I've traveled this road

I don't imagine any of you are old enough to remember the streets of Hamilton in the mid 1950's are you? I remember them well, particularly the intersection of Main and Dundurn. That's where my father ran the B/A service station on the south west corner, one of 4 stations at that intersection, where I "helped" him on weekends, distributing flyers and keeping the place tidy. There was nothing unusual about that intersection or Main St. in general, they were built many years before and were pretty typical of Hamilton in that era. You can pop down to the library and check out the historical picture collection if you're curious. Dad had always wanted a business of his own and over the years he had developed a steady clientele and was making a decent living. But that intersection and Main St. in general were struggling to meet the needs of the modern city of the 50's and weren't going to work in the future. The age of the automobile was in full flight. Almo st every family owned a car, some even had two. Sunday drives were all the rage and kids champed at the bit and pestered their parents to get their licences. Gridlock 50's style was beginning and the future looked bleak unless something changed. Something did. City council, bravely facing the future, closed the intersection, tore up Main St. and began the process of transforming the city into what you see today. There was strong opposition to the project, of course, which I'm sure you can access through the archives of The Spectator. I was young, but I remember the dinner table talk. Business owners were worried, residents were concerned about the loss of what they held dear and there was lots of "it was good enough for us" resistance and "what about my potholes?" complaints. But the present situation wasn't good enough and certainly wasn't going to be good enough for the future and council had the foresight and courage to recognize that. The signs we nt up, shovels hit the ground and life, our family life for sure, changed. Dad's business went under as did many others. But dad was too strong to let something like that defeat him, he reinvented himself, changed jobs, put his son through university and reluctantly retired from a job he loved when he was forced out at 80. The result of council's decision in the 50's is the Main St. you know today, perfect for the needs of the final half of the 20th century. Times changed, council understood that and adapted in the face of strong opposition.

Times continue to change and the Hamilton of the last century won't begin to meet the needs of the future. I'm an old guy but I see the future in my children and grandchildren. Worldwide trends see the next generations wanting to live and work in the centre of cities. They are buying and refurbishing shabby houses. They don't share our love affair with the automobile, preferring bicycles, public transit and, gasp, Uber-like services. They think green, aren't big on diesel fumes, and worry about the future of our environment. And they form a solid tax base in areas once dependent on huge social service outlays. Business and residential development is following them downtown and changing rundown, money-sucking cores into vibrant, money-producing landscapes. How is council going to respond to this change and to the needs of our children and grandchildren? Are you going to have the courage of your mid-20th century forbearers and adapt or are you going to fight to maintain a status quo that will see Hamilton side-tracked by business, industry and development that will chose

locales which have an eye to the future. LRT is ours for the taking and is precisely what is needed, not necessarily for you and me, but for our children and grandchildren and their children. Yes, the process won't be pretty. There will be disruption, some businesses will fail, others will reinvent themselves and neighbourhoods will change. I've seen this before in my lifetime and it will continue to happen over and over. That's the social history of the world and, like it or not, we can't dig in our heels and stop it. The province is picking up the tab for LRT so they obviously see a bright future for our city. I share their optimism. Do you? I urge you not to drop the ball on this.

A report released in 2014 entitled Improving Health by Design in the Greater Toronto-Hamilton Area (GTHA) reveals that improvements in the ways communities are designed and integrate public transportation would result in the prevention of over 300 premature deaths and over 1,000 cases of diabetes each year across the GTHA. The report is the result of an important collaboration by the medical officers of health for Toronto, Peel, Simcoe Muskoka and Hamilton.

Current challenges linked to urban sprawl:

- · Obesity and inactivity cost \$4 billion a year in the GTHA.
- Diabetes rates are rising rapidly, with over 12,500 new cases occurring each year due to inactivity.
- Traffic congestion in the GTHA has resulted in the longest commute times in Canada, with economic cost of \$6 billion in lost productivity each year.
- Traffic-related air pollution is responsible for over 850 premature deaths a year and over 3,300 hospitalizations.
- Communities are built around the automobile, eliminating regular physical activity from people's lives such as walking to school or the corner store or accessing frequent, convenient transit service.

Risks of expected growth in the GTHA:

- Over the next 20 years, the population in the GTHA is projected to grow by over two million people.
- If we do not change how we design communities and transportation systems, the current issues outlined above will get much worse:
- a 33 per cent increase in commute times
- a 200 per cent increase in economic costs of lost productivity due to congestion
- a 27 per cent increase in small particulate air pollution from traffic emissions
- a 30 per cent increase in greenhouse gas emissions from traffic, and
- nearly double the amount of diabetes, with one in six adults being affected.

"We are calling on all governments to take a more active role in ensuring that both existing and new communities are planned to make the health of their residents a top priority," said Dr. David Mowat, Medical Officer of Health for the Region of Peel and spokesperson for the collective of medical officers of health. "While improvements are occurring in community design, considering the rate of population growth, chronic disease trends and the pace of change in land use and transportation planning, it is clear that more needs to be done. We have built our communities around the automobile and this approach poses a serious risk to public health."

The four medical officers (TO, Peel, Simcoe Muskoka & **Hamilton**) of health have developed three key recommendations for policy makers and municipal and provincial leaders on the design of healthy communities:

- 1. Invest in public transit.
- 2. Strengthen provincial policies that support transit and active transportation.
- 3. Make transit and active transportation planning integral to city planning.

These recommendations provide a template for action that will help improve human health.

"Active transportation - walking and cycling as well as using public transit - allows our residents to build non-recreational physical activity into each day. These actions not only improve health by increasing activity but also decrease air pollution that leads to premature deaths, heart disease and respiratory conditions," continued Dr. Mowat.

Obesity and physical inactivity already cost the GTHA \$4 billion a year and traffic-related air pollution is responsible for over 850 premature deaths annually. In the next 20 years, the population of the GTHA is projected to grow by another 2.2 million people. The report calls for leadership in city and transit planning to ensure communities that encourage healthy lifestyles are built.

The four medical officers of health who collaborated on this project are Dr. David Mowat, Peel; Dr. David McKeown, Toronto; Dr. Charles Gardner, Simcoe Muskoka; and Dr. Ninh Tran, Hamilton.

Backgrounder

Improving Health by Design in the Greater Toronto-Hamilton Area (GTHA) is a report that was co-authored by the medical officers of health for Toronto, Peel Region, Simcoe Muskoka and Hamilton. It describes why we need major changes in how we design communities.

Specifically, creating communities that support greater walking, cycling and public transit use would improve the public's health by building physical activity back into people's lives and reducing air pollution. The report estimates that increases in physical activity would prevent over 180 premature deaths each year and prevent over 1,000 cases of diabetes a year in the GTHA. Reduction in traffic-related air pollution would prevent an additional 154 premature deaths each year.

Recommendations

1. Invest in public transit

Investments need to be made in public transit that will encourage greater use by making it more convenient, reliable and accessible across the GTHA. In addition to reducing congestion, reducing air pollution and providing a lower cost transportation option, taking public transit incorporates physical activity into a person's day. For example, 29 per cent of public transit users in the US achieve the recommended 30 minutes a day of daily physical activity just by their transit use.

Leadership and collaboration is needed between federal, provincial and municipal governments to foster a network of transit and active transportation alternatives that cross city boundaries and link the municipalities of the GTHA. Metrolinx's The Big Move is an example of a visionary transit plan that can have a significant impact on the health and wellbeing of GTHA residents. It would see new transportation projects amounting to two billion dollars in investment annually over the next 25 years, including over 1,200 km of additional rapid transit and over 7,000 km of new pathways and trails for pedestrians and cyclists.

2. Strengthen provincial policies that support transit and active transportation

Healthy, complete communities support design for walking, cycling and transit use, providing access to a range of housing, retail, services and employment. Several provincial laws, policies and plans direct or influence how communities are designed. These need to further strengthen their support for the development of healthy, complete communities.

For example, Places to Grow is a key long-range plan for the GTHA to revitalize downtowns, create complete communities, curb urban sprawl and reduce congestion by supporting a greater range of transportation options. The plan has existed for almost 10 years and is subject to review in the near future providing an opportunity to identify how it can more strongly support the development of healthy complete communities.

3. Make transit and active transportation planning integral to city planning

When communities are developed, plans for water, sewage, roads and utilities automatically occur. In order to achieve healthy complete communities, planning for walking, cycling and transit use also needs to become routine throughout city planning steps. If the planning for active transportation and transit use is addressed as an exception to be accommodated as an afterthought or only for recreational purposes, then the potential health and other benefits will not be realized.

When people use public transit it is possible to get 30 minutes of exercise each day. Whether it is walking or cycling back and forth to the bus stop or climbing the stairs in the subway. This is what is meant by active transportation.

Here are some facts that should be considered. It astounds me that some councilors are playing politics with our future.

- The revenue sharing arrangement has not been finalized yet. It is one of the issues being negotiated under the Memorandum of Agreement between Metrolinx and the City.
- Hamilton will not be responsible for the operational and maintenance costs. The LRT system will be owned and operated by Metrolinx.
- Emergency vehicles will be able to use the LRT right-of-way, just as they do in other cities that have LRT systems.
- The Province has clearly stated that Hamilton taxpayers will not be responsible if the project goes over budget. If necessary, the project will be scaled back to keep it in budget. However, Metrolinx has an excellent track record of staying in budget, e.g. the Eglinton Crosstown LRT, which is much larger and more complicated than Hamilton's system and is on time and on budget.
- The overall construction time is expected to be 4-5 years, but the construction is likely to be staged so that each segment of the route is closed for a shorter period of time to minimize business disruption.
- The construction period will be challenging for businesses, but the City and Metrolinx are already committed to working proactively with business owners to ensure they emerge successful from the construction period. In addition, a citizen campaign is already being organized to promote and support affected businesses during construction.
- The underground infrastructure that will be replaced is very old and soon due for replacement anyway. If we turn down the LRT investment, the businesses will still have to go through the reconstruction phase, but without a rapid transit system at the end.
- By having underground infrastructure replaced under the Provincial LRT budget, the City is saving tens of millions of dollars in infrastructure replacement capital spending, which it can distribute to other parts of the city that need road reconstruction.
- All property purchases will be covered by Metrolinx under the LRT capital budget. Of around 260 identified properties, most are just a thin sliver of land next to the public ROW. The total cost will be nowhere near the made-up \$500 million number.
- There is absolutely no reason to think the new bridge over Highway 403 will cost anywhere near \$1 billion, another made-up number. In any case, Metrolinx owns the project and is responsible for the budget.
- The transit-only lane was only two kilometres long and ran for just over a year. It was actually quite successful by a variety of measures, and in two separate surveys, a clear majority of Hamiltonians supported keeping it and tweaking the design to make it work better.
- LRT stops are spaced more widely than bus stops because that is proven to work more successfully in rapid transit systems. However, the location of stops has not yet been

finalized, so Hamiltonians have an opportunity to recommend changes (e.g. adding a stop at International Village).

• Current ridership is over 30,000 trips a day, which would put Hamilton's LRT right in the mid-range of successful LRT systems in North America on opening day. In any case, Metrolinx is responsible to cover the operational costs of the system.

Hamilton's current LRT plan is just the first phase of a larger rapid transit network across Hamilton that will extend into Stoney Creek, south to the Airport and across the mountain.

- Building LRT will free up city buses that can be used to increase transit service in other parts of the city.
- Bus Rapid Transit is cheaper to build but more expensive to operate: each vehicle can carry fewer passengers, so more vehicles and drivers are needed. BRT also has a much lower maximum capacity. Ottawa, for example, built BRT (Transitway) instead of LRT and is now being forced to upgrade to LRT because their bus system is at capacity.
- BRT is just as disruptive as LRT during construction, since the roadbed has to be rebuilt to accommodate the weight of a high volume of express articulated buses. It also runs in dedicated lanes, so it will disrupt vehicle traffic just as much as LRT but with much lower economic uplift.
