I am one of the leads of one of the local LRT citizen advocacies of Hamilton.

I wanted to write you quickly, to thank you very much for your open letter. We're excited about how the Hamilton LRT will help revitalize Hamilton. We are encouraged to hear Federal is very interested in investing further in Hamilton (which is already happening, including the Randle Reef and other initiatives).

We know that the Federal government is very happy to fund infrastructure and are excited at the potential opportunities this could bring.

We would be very happy to help, including the possibility of:

- -- Helping Hamilton further the 10-Year Rapid Ready Plan (a bus explansion to fit the LRT)
- -- A miniature incremental A-Line extension to St. Joeseph Hospital and Mohawk College, with possible short T-Line spur to Limeridge Mall.

One problem is we have a "416-vs-905" style divide in the form of "Mountain-vs-Lower City" (and Dundas/Stoney Creek). If Hamilton LRT could expand eastwards, westwards and southwards -- just like Ottawa Phase 2, then this could bring more local anti-LRT Hamiltonians into being pro-LRT.

I realize this is a little early for this discussion, but if we look at Ottawa timescales, I suggest a mere initiative of making the Hamilton LRT A-Line shovel-ready by 2018.

The cost of a study and Environment Assessment to make the A-Line Hamilton LRT shovel-ready would be a great way to make many residents that the Hamilton LRT is not a static project and can undergo incremental extensions. Bringing the Hamilton Mountain onboard will do a huge benefit for the Hamilton LRT.

I propose we all work together to get the City to raise a Motion to ask for Federal funding for a study/EA of an incremental Hamilton LRT extension, in order to make it at least simply *shovel-ready* on time for the 2018 election. This could help tip the scales on electorate support.

Building the light rail line provides a crucial step in building Hamilton's capacity as a resilient city, better able to respond to currently unfolding challenges related to resource depletion and economic uncertainty.

In the way of energy use, light rail makes for a highly-efficient mode of transport within an urban setting, combined with its greater capacity for carrying passengers, when we compare it to busses. On its own right-of-way, it offers a mode of transport comparable to private cars in terms of speed(Last Saturday night, in southern Etobicoke part of Toronto, my wife and I saw a 1980-vintage TTC streetcar travelling along at roughly 70 km/h between stops on Lakeshore Blvd., with light car traffic).

With respect to improving bus service, light rail provides a highly-effective anchor for bus routes running north-south, especially up on the Mountain. It allows us to transfer more quickly between busses from one end of Hamilton to the other, much like the subway lines operate(and Eglinton Crosstown light rail line will operate) in Toronto.

With respect to the critical issue of resource depletion, particularly the peak in production of conventional or crude oil: easy-to-get and highest net energy source. It is essential to consider the following, not to lull ourselves into complacency over relatively low energy prices.

The drop in energy prices has arisen essentially because of a drop in demand stemming from deepening downturn in the Global Economy, not from any significant rise in production.

In the last few years, energy companies have made lowest levels of discoveries of new deposits, despite having doubled their budgets for exploration in the 2002-2012 period.

Even when energy prices were higher, over \$100 a barrel for crude oil, major energy companies were in precarious financial situation, where debt has outweighed revenue by \$100 billion for the world's top 127 energy companies, let alone the rash of bankruptcies happening amongst smaller companies with a focus on the once highly-touted shale oil and gas deposits in the US.

In a recent review of the 2012 Global energy Assessment, in a scholarly journal, author Michael Jefferson cited that the figure of "proved conventional oil reserves of nearly 1.7 trillion is overstated by 875 billion barrels: over the half the total figure. This overstating comes from including Canadian Tar Sands and Venezuelan heavy oil in with conventional oil, even if both sources are very different in quality, particularly in terms of their much lower net energy value when we compare them to conventional oil. Also, the

higher figure came from including conventional oil reserves with a 50% probability of being proven in those having 90% probability, which started in 1984.

The decision that you collectively as City Council members, particularly to reject provincial funding for an LRT line(to start the process of rebuilding a network of LRT lines) will have deep repercussions over the long term, in regards to coping with such longer term trends as Peak Oil and on-going Financial Crisis. Light rail provides a most effective way of travelling in an urban area(even within a regional area) within the context of declining energy production, in the way of net energy.

They understand that rapid transportation and strong infrastructure is the catalyst to a city's growth, while they laugh at how Hamilton drags its feet on the issue of whether or not to use a gifted \$1 billion dedicated ONLY for LRT. We are already years behind and will only fall further behind if this project isn't greenlit immediately and jump-started swiftly.

Hello, Mr Merulla.

We are very glad to know that you are concerned about Hamilton councillors commitment to the LRT project, and that you are bringing forward a motion to gauge LRT support.

Firstly, the decision about the LRT should be based on long term projections for the growth and demographics of Hamilton, transportation needs and plans by other levels of government, including GO transit and assessment of HSR in its present form.

The present proposal links LRT with the Harbour GO station, but does not link with the proposed GO station at the north end of Centennial Parkway. Also it does not link up with the present Eastgate Square which is now a hub for transfers and which also has a large parking area for cars. There are a large number of retirement/seniors homes being constructed in the Stoney Creek area including one on King Street and another down by the Lake Ontario at the bottom of Millen Road. Seniors will use the bus much more and this will means a lot of getting off and on buses for them if Eastgate Sqare does not have the LTR. Additionally there are a large number of apartments close to Eastgate and these residents, like seniors are higher users of public transport. Carl Turkstra's article in today's Hamilton Spectator indicates that a review of the frequency and type of service offered by HSR needs to be re-examined and how does it fit with the LRT plan.

Secondly, the decision need to be based on hard fact. We are all tax payers, be it federal, provincial or municipal. The money for projects must come from these sources and must be fully justified. At the present time we have not seen a sound justification for spending a billion dollars to put LRT in Hamilton. Cities are built for people

Every new home built in a subdivision will add one to four cars to our streets and highways, but our cities were not built for cars.

To accommodate city streets to car traffic, massive destructive interventions have destroyed livelihood and lifestyle and caused, as we well know by now, enormous damage to the environment.

We can only recuperate the cities or our living spaces by rethinking away from carbon dependent individual transit and change to comfortable, rapid and easily accessible public transit.

Starting by building the B-line in lower hamilton but very importantly, extend the system with A-line, preferably by tunneling up the escarpment to connect upper Hamilton to downtown and the airport to the GO station. A second north-south line parallel to the A-line should link upper to lower Hamilton in a walking distance of not more than 400m from the user. Interest rates are at historic low, the best time to invest into the future. Infrastructural investments of this kind are meant for 100 years and more. There is plenty of time to amortise even huge investments over this period of time (as it happened in many parts of the world) and remember, people pay a user fee, not like driving on the road. Our future is not the danger of a financial indebtedness, our future is an unreparable damage to the environment and to the city unless we wake up now.
