#### HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

The Advisory Committee for Persons with Disabilities is a sub-committee of Council providing advice and making recommendations to Council and City staff regarding City policies, procedures and guidelines that address the needs and concerns of persons with disabilities, including providing input regarding the preparation, implementation and monitoring of the *Ontarians with Disabilities*, 2001 Act and the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act and their regulations.

At their October 11, 2016 meeting, the Advisory Committee for Persons with Disabilities gave consideration to their budget needs for 2017. The budget includes the costs for one or two committee members to attend an accessibility conference or seminar that is relevant to the work of the Committee.

#### POLICY IMPLICATIONS AND LEGISLATED REQUIREMENTS

There are no policy implications and legislated requirements.

## **RELEVANT CONSULTATION**

The Advisory Committee for Persons with Disabilities discussed their 2017 budget needs at their October 11, 2016 meeting.

## ANALYSIS AND RATIONALE FOR RECOMMENDATION

The recommendation will provide funding for one or two members of the Advisory Committee for Persons with Disabilities to attend a yearly accessibility conference and thus enable them to fulfil their terms of reference.

#### ALTERNATIVES FOR CONSIDERATION

The alternative would be not to fund the request made by the ACPD. However, this is not recommended. The ability for two members each year to attend an accessibility conference has a multitude of benefits to the advisory Committee members and the Committee's work overall. By attending, the members are accessing and engaging in educational, networking and knowledge exchange opportunities. By participating in these conferences, Committee members bring their voices and lived experiences to the table that might otherwise not be heard.
