Recently Britain stood still for 2 minutes to commemorate when the whistles blew in trenches for the Battle of the Somme.

2017 is the 100th anniversary of Vimy – suggestion that on a Sunday in 2017 Hamiltonians could be asked to pause for a collective remembrance, churches could be asked to ring their bells.

6. NEW BUSINESS

6.1 MP Bob Bratina, House of Commons Veterans Committee

The House of Commons Veterans Committee is hearing witness testimony on the mandate of the above committee, not to change the mandate of service, but rather to ensure services that are in place are being delivered. There has been much testimony about the lack of resources. The anticipated outcome is recommendations as to how they can ensure the veterans that are entitled to a certain service can receive it. WWII Veterans have a clear understanding while more recent veterans do not. Recent veterans need to be made aware of what is available to them. The committee hopes to better understand how they can get that info to the more recent veterans. One gap seems to be at the active service level, as personnel are in their service period, they are not made aware or offered help to prepare for post-service (although this is Suggestions that have come forward to date are: issuing identification that identifies the person as a veteran to be presented when requesting assistance making their information easier to access. One challenge is moving info from active service profiles to veterans as many do not want to admit they are having physical challenges, many want to avoid stigma and financial concerns. Consultations are continuing. Fred Smith is speaking to the issue of homeless veterans. Their military training makes it easy for them to hide for whatever reason. The HoCVC wants to ensure it is a seamless transition from DND to DVA.

They will be meeting at end of August reviewing results. Bob will provide a regular info update on the status of the committee.

6.2 Proposed work to improve flag mount system on Gore Park Cenotaph

6.3 Afghanistan Memorial - LAV

North Wall Riders Association has received approval from Canadian Warplane Heritage Museum to install the LAV at their site. The NWRA has funds to pay for LAV but will be raising funds for installation, etc. At this time, all of the Hamilton regiments are on board. Plan is for a Spring 2017 dedication.
